


## To increase carbon pricing literacy we need to foster


#### Part II – 90 minutes

## Important



- 1. The youths must be CCL/CCI members or willing to join a CCL/CCI group. There is a commitment from a CCL/CCI group to support them.
- 2. CCI/CCL Group helpers should anticipate about 10-15 hours of work between September and December helping their younger members achieve their certificate.



## The Certificate

## Certificate of completion will be rewarded when the youth completes 5 of 7 actions:

- 1. Attends the September conference and files a report in the Action Tracker on CCL Community
- 2. Fills in a testimonial on why they support climate income that we can post on our local, national and CCI social media channels and websites
- 3. Creates a short video that we can post on our local, national and CCI social media channels and websites
- 4. Appears in the mainstream news either TV, radio, or print and provides us with a web link or other proof of publication such as a photo and files a report in the Action Tracker on CCL Community
- 5. Creates a capstone document about carbon pricing in their country and files that report in the Action Tracker on CCL Community
- 6. Organizes an event and files that report in the Action Tracker on CCL Community
- 7. Lobbies a politician and/or asks a question to a politician at a town hall and files a report in the Action Tracker on CCL Community





## Registration



### Process

From August 1 to August 14 youth and young adults apply online to be a delegate at the conference.

Applicants and their helpers will receive confirmation by August 21. They will be sent Zoom registration forms for the Webinar and Workshops.

The general public will be sent an invitation to the webinar in late August and and again in early September.

We hope to announce firm plans by August 21.




